## MWMO Updating Watershed Management Plan

The Mississippi Watershed Management Organization (MWMO) is updating its Watershed Management Plan. This plan, which is updated every 10 years in accordance with state law, guides all of the work at the MWMO. It summarizes the environment in which they do their work. It lays out their goals, strategies and actions to protect and improve water quality and habitat in the watershed. It also guides local water management planning for communities within the MWMO watershed.

The MWMO will be working to update the plan over the next two years, following the process outlined in these laws: Minnesota Statutes



103B and Minnesota Rules 8410. During this process, the MWMO will seek input from various stakeholders, including the public, state agencies and local governments, about local stormwater-related issues, water management goals, regulations and programs.

## Free Immunizations Before School Starts

Minneapolis is encouraging people to get their children caught up on immunizations before school starts, and to help it's offering free immunizations on eight dates in August and September. No need for appointments or insurance. The "MMR" immunization is safe and effective, and it protects against measles, mumps and rubella.

### Measles can be dangerous, and it's contagious

Measles can be dangerous – especially for babies and young children. About one in five people who get measles will be hospitalized. Measles can lead to pneumonia, brain damage, deafness and even death. Measles spreads easily through coughing and sneezing, and the germs can stick around in a room or a car for hours after a sick person has left.

This year so far, 1,164 measles cases have been confirmed in the United States – the most since 1992.
