## Stable Homes Stable Schools Initiative Update

Stable Homes Stable Schools is a collaborative effort by the City of Minneapolis, the Minneapolis Public Housing Authority (MPHA), Minneapolis Public Schools (MPS), and Hennepin County Health & Human Services to provide funding and services for families facing the threat of losing their home or experiencing homelessness. The goal is to support as many as 650 students during the initiative's first three years.

The first 21 families enrolled in the Stable Homes Stable Schools initiative have secured permanent housing or received help to stay in

their housing. Six families have received rental assistance and moved into permanent housing, and another 15 families have received one-time emergency assistance through the Housing Stability Fund to maintain their housing and prevent homelessness.

The program needs additional rental units for families throughout Minneapolis. Property owners with current and upcoming vacancies interested in participating should contact the Minneapolis Public Housing Authority at [OwnerOutreach@MplsPHA.org](mailto:OwnerOutreach@MplsPHA.org) or 612-342-1222.

## Northern Metals Ordered to Cease Operations in N. Minneapolis



**Northern Metals in North Minneapolis**

MINNEAPOLIS (WCCO) — Northern Metals Recycling is ordered to stop its shredding operations in north Minneapolis on October 15<sup>th</sup>, according to the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency. It comes after MPCA alleges the company had been altering its pollution control readings.

A hearing on the matter is scheduled for September 23<sup>rd</sup>.

The company is also required to get a third party to conduct air monitoring on site and immediately give its results to the MPCA.

Last month, a whistleblower came forward with accusations against the company. The man said he was told not to write down pollution control equipment readings above a certain level and he alerted the MPCA. Documents show an inspector looked at the records and found alterations.

The MPCA settled with the shredding company on another issue in 2017, ending in a \$2.5 million fine. And the recycling company was supposed to close its north Minneapolis facility by August 1<sup>st</sup> and move to a new location. The court allowed Northern Metals to continue operating until the parties resolved the disagreement.

The group Community Members for Environmental Justice has also been added as a party alongside the MPCA and the city of Minneapolis for the lawsuit against Northern Metals.
