Taking a Walk? Keep the Neighborhood Beautiful!

Spring is here and the weather is shaping up beautifully for walks and strolls around the neighborhood.

Next time you go for a walk, grab a pair of garden gloves and a trash bag, and pick up litter along the way! Dispose of the trash bag in your own garbage can for weekly pickup; a little effort goes a long way for the good of the neighborhood.

It's an easy way to care for our community, and help make Marshall Terrace a great place to live, work, and create.



Order a Compost Bin or Rain Barrel

Get a jump-start on gardening by ordering a \$55 compost bin or a \$69 rain barrel for your home from the Recycling Association of Minnesota (RAM). They regularly cost \$105 and \$139.

By using a compost bin, you can keep more than a quarter of your household waste out of the garbage while making valuable compost for your garden.

A rain barrel will help you save water and money by using rainwater rather than the faucet for your garden and trees. Rain barrels are also a way of trapping the stormwater that runs toward the storm drains, picks up pollutants along the way, and travels into our lakes, streams, and rivers.

Order now from RAM, and pick up your compost bin or rain barrel in Minneapolis on **Saturday, May 30th** at Minneapolis Public Works Storage Facility, 3607 East 44th Street in Minneapolis.

Columbia Parkway Trail Closure

– *via The Northeaster*

Due to a project by Xcel Energy, the Columbia Parkway Trail, between Central Avenue NE and 35th Avenue NE, will be closed April 6–June 30.

Pedestrian and bike traffic will be detoured onto the sidewalk along the north side of Columbia Parkway. Trail traffic needing to cross Central Avenue NE will be diverted up to 37th Avenue NE. Xcel Energy will also be closing off the East/West parking lot section of the Xcel Energy Fields parking lot on Marshall Street NE at 31st Avenue NE.

St. Anthony Parkway Off-Leash Dog Park

Did you know there's a City-sanctioned off-leash dog park close to Marshall Terrace?

Let your dog run off-leash, play, and make new friends at St. Anthony Parkway Off-Leash Dog Park!

It's located at **700 St. Anthony Parkway**, on the south side of the Parkway across the street from Columbia Park Golf Learning Center. The parking lot is located west of the Learning Center near the kiosk.



To use the park, residents must purchase an Off-Leash Dog Park Permit. (Before buying a permit, you must vaccinate your dog[s] for rabies and have a City of Minneapolis Pet License for the dog[s]). The permit is valid at all seven Minneapolis Off-Leash Dog Parks.

PLEASE NOTE

CCMT has received reports of people climbing the fence at Rod Carew All-Star Field with their dogs, and letting the dogs run freely on the field. In addition to trespassing, **this is a violation of Minneapolis Statute PB2-18** which requires dogs to be *“effectively restrained by chain or leash not exceeding eight (8) feet in length, except in areas officially designated for off leash.”*
