The CCMT board meets monthly to discuss neighborhood issues, allocate city funds, and work to make Marshall Terrace a great place to live, work, and create.



## Recreational Fires: Play by the Rules

Residents who like to enjoy a small outdoor recreational fire should be considerate of their neighbors and make sure they are abiding by City ordinances:

- Outdoor fires are permitted between 9:00AM and 10:00PM.
- Keep fires small, less than three feet in diameter and two feet high.
- Burn only untreated, unpainted, dry wood. Never burn cardboard boxes, trash, or debris because the smoke can be toxic.
- Fires must be at least 25 feet away from a structure or combustible material and in a fire ring or pit with edges more than six inches high.
- Have a hose or fire extinguisher present.
- Postpone the fire when the wind exceeds 10 mph.
- Fire must be constantly attended by someone 18 years or older and completely out before being abandoned.

## Deadline to Apply for a Raingarden: May 31<sup>st</sup>



Want to do your part to improve the watershed that feeds the Mississippi River? Interested in a pollinator-friendly garden in your yard?

Raingardens are beautiful landscaping features that protect water quality and provide habitat for pollinators. They use native plants and capture rainwater runoff so it can filter through the soil instead of flowing into storm drains and directly into our lakes and rivers.

The Concerned Citizens of Marshall Terrace (CCMT) and Metro Blooms are partnering to work with property owners (*residential, business, and places of worship*) to install raingardens in the neighborhood. Property owners would pay for a small portion of the project. (*Total cost depends on size and scope of each project.*) Metro Blooms would design the gardens, coordinate the installations, and order materials, so all property owners have to do is plant.
