Yard Waste Collection Ends November 17th

The last 2014 collection day for leaves, brush, and other yard trimmings is your garbage day during the week of November 17th.

Yard waste must be in paper bags, compostable plastic bags, or in a reusable container at least 26" high with sturdy handles. (Yard waste is not allowed in City-provided containers.) Set all yard waste next to your garbage cart by 6:00AM. Guidelines for yard waste are as follows:

Leaves

- Each bag/container must weigh less than 40 pounds

Brush

- Each bundle must weigh less than 40 pounds
- Each bundle must be less than 3 feet long
- Branch size less than 3" in diameter
- Must be bundled with string (no tape)

Send Us Your GAF Impact Statements

Residents of the Marshall Terrace and Bottineau neighborhoods have formed a task force in an effort to ensure that the odor/fume issue caused by GAF Materials Corp. at 50 Lowry Ave. N. resolves quickly and thoroughly. GAF is committing \$500k towards a solution and this task force will monitor the progress of this resolution through its completion.

Minneapolis 311 has been inundated with calls from all over Northeast Minneapolis this year about the odor issue. Residents have reported a wide range of effects including sore throats, irritated eyes, nausea, and the need to stay inside with doors and windows shut.

We are collecting examples of these stories in the form of **Impact Statements**; we're **asking you to share with us how the odor/fumes from GAF have affected your household's quality of life.**

Your Impact Statement can be as short or long as you'd like, and can include:

- Incidents in which the fumes negatively impacted your life or your family's life
- Acute/chronic health effects that are caused by the fumes to you and your family
- Acute/chronic emotional effects that are caused by the fumes to you and your family

Please also be sure to **include your address or the nearest intersection** at which the fumes are experienced by you.

Energy Assistance Program

Following the termination by the State of Minnesota of its contracts with Community Action of Minneapolis, Community Action Partnership of Suburban Hennepin (CAPSH) now administers the Energy Assistance Program in Minneapolis.

The Energy Assistance Program can help you pay energy costs-- such as a heating bill-- between Oct 1 and May 30 each year. **If you qualify, you could receive a grant to cover some of your energy expenses.** This grant is paid directly to your energy provider, to reduce your energy bill.

Additionally, if you receive Energy Assistance, you may qualify for weatherization services. These services can improve your home's energy efficiency and lower your energy bill. Furnace repair or replacement assistance is also available.

The Energy Assistance application can be downloaded online at www.capsh.org or by calling 952-930-3541.

Minneapolis residents who already submitted an application to Community Action of Minneapolis do not need to submit new applications unless notified by CAPSH.

Energy Assistance applications that were previously submitted to Community Action of Minneapolis will be delivered to CAPSH and processed in the order in which they were received.
