Marshall Terrace Organics Recycling Update

Green organics recycling carts for collecting food scraps, food-soiled paper products, and other compostable items such as coffee grounds, dryer lint, and pet and human hair are now dotting alleys and curbsides around the city.

As of October 26, 2015 just over 31% of the City's solid waste and recycling customers have signed up for organics recycling; that is just over 33,500 households participating. Solid Waste & Recycling have delivered a cart to over 12,000 homes in Phase 1 neighborhoods. Another 21,548 households have signed up in Phase 2 neighborhoods; Phase 2 households will receive carts next spring.



Half of Marshall Terrace is in Phase 1 and can get a cart now! There is no additional cost to residents to sign up. To sign up, contact Solid Waste & Recycling at 612-673-3536 or SWRcustomer@minneapolismn.gov.

Here are two good reasons to participate:

- **Reduce waste.** More than a third of our trash is organic material that can be composted. Most families can divert up to 10 pounds of materials to organics recycling each week.
- **Compost more.** Things like meat, bones, dairy products, and compostable plastics can't go in a backyard composting bin, but they can be collected through organics recycling and turned into compost. Using compost returns nutrients to the soil, reduces erosion, and reduces the needs for watering and for chemical fertilizers. This is especially important in Marshall Terrace; our rainwater flows from storm drains directly into the Mississippi River.

St. Anthony Bridge CLOSED to Bike/Pedestrian Traffic

The St. Anthony Parkway Bridge over the Northtown Yard is closed to all traffic, including bicycle and pedestrians, as of Monday, November 2nd, 2015. The intersection of California Street and St. Anthony Parkway, as well as the Main Street and St. Anthony Parkway intersection, will also remain closed and fenced off for the remainder of construction.

Closing the bridge to all traffic, including bicycles and pedestrians, will allow the contractor to safely work on preparing the truss spans for demolition. Demolition and removal of the trusses is scheduled to begin this winter.

Safety is a top priority with this project and everyone is encouraged to keep a safe distance from the construction site. You can safely monitor the project via the live web cam on the project website: www.stapbridge.com/live-webcam.

Master Water Stewards Program



Are you concerned about water pollution? Then you may want to consider joining the **Master Water Stewards** program to learn how to solve environmental problems in Marshall Terrace, and find a local network for energized leaders.

The Master Water Stewards program is a partnership between the **Freshwater Society** and participating Watershed Districts, including the **Mississippi Watershed Management Organization (MWMO)**. The program certifies and supports community leaders to install pollution prevention projects that educate community members, reduce pollutants from urban runoff, and allow more water to soak into the ground before running into storm sewer systems.
