Fall Street Sweeping & Yard Waste



Fall Street Sweeping

Street sweeping is one way in which the City of Minneapolis works to protect the environment; it keeps leaves and debris from clogging our storm drains and polluting our lakes and rivers. It also helps keep our neighborhoods clean and livable.

Minneapolis streets are swept completely curb to curb once in the spring and once in the fall. **This fall's sweep will begin Tuesday, October 20th.**

Streets will be posted at least 24 hours in advance. Parking on posted streets is prohibited from 7:00 AM – 4:30 PM.

Yard Waste Collection

Yard Waste Collection will end the week of November 16th, 2015.

Your last yard waste collection will be on your regularly scheduled garbage day during the week of November 16th.

Place yard waste out, prepared to collection guidelines, each week on your garbage day for collection. Minnesota state law prohibits disposing of yard waste with garbage and requires the use of compostable bags for collection of yard waste from your home.

The Red River Oxcart Trail

Do you have a story about the Red River Oxcart Trail? Minneapolis Riverfront Partnership wants to hear from you!

The Red River Oxcart Trail was an important route in the fur trade in the mid-1800s. Traders moved furs and buffalo hides from Pembina, near the Canadian border, to St. Paul, where they were shipped east. The children of European traders and American Indian women were central to this trade, thanks to their language skills, social ties, and knowledge of the land. Others used the trail too, including statesmen, soldiers, and eventually settlers seeking homesteads to the north.

The Minneapolis Riverfront Partnership is developing an audio bike tour for a portion of



the trail that followed the Mississippi River from Anoka to St. Anthony Falls. Are you descended from someone who traveled the trail? Have you heard stories about family members who worked in the fur trade? Tell us about it!

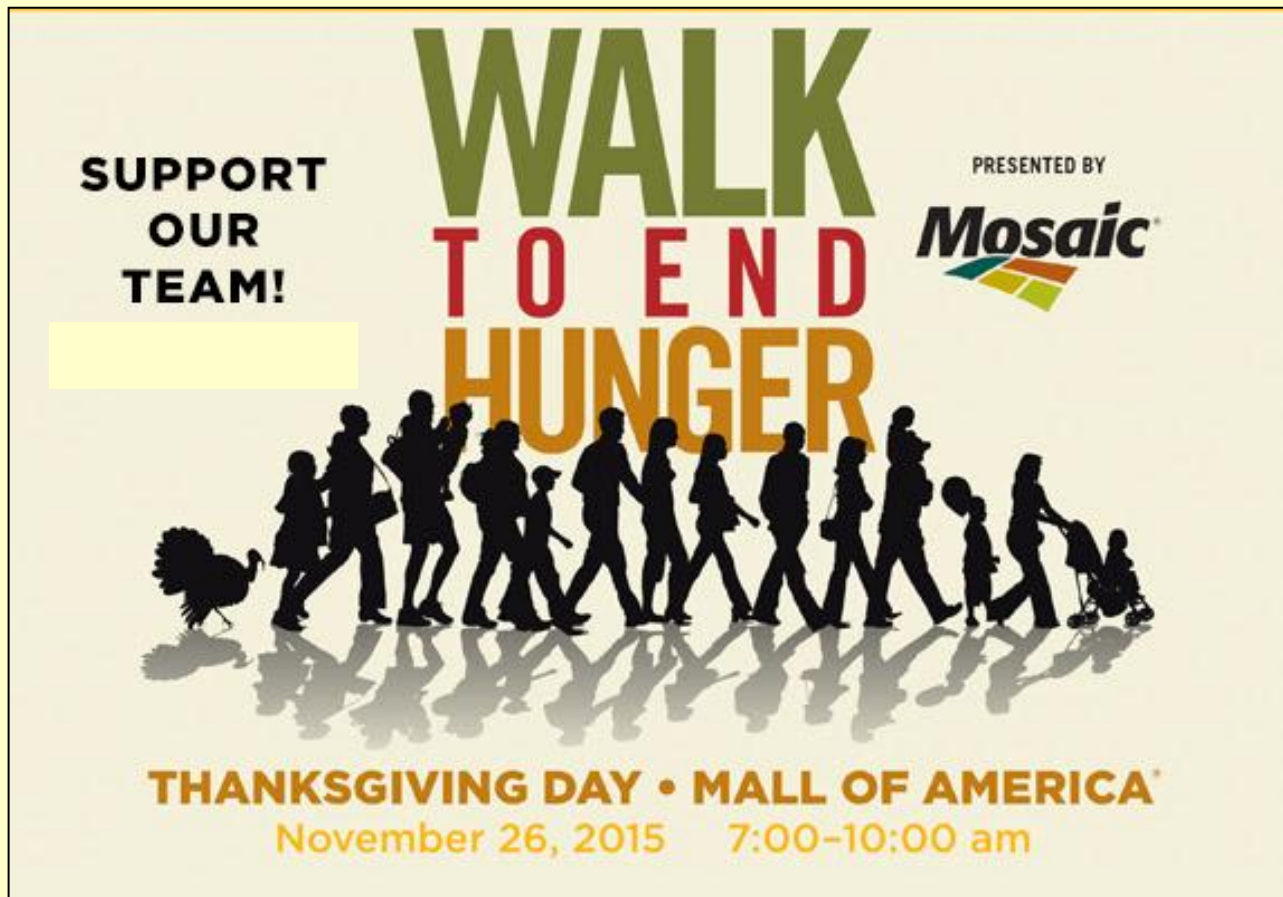
